

John S. Wadsworth, Jr. '61. Jack is currently an Advisory Director at Morgan Stanley. After an MBA from the University of Chicago, Jack began at First Boston in 1963. By 1978 he was Executive Vice President, member of the Board, and Co-head of First Boston's investment banking group. In 1978, he joined Morgan Stanley and started Morgan Stanley's technology investment banking practice and venture capital business. From 1986 to 1991, he built Morgan Stanley's business in Japan from the ground up, and as Chairman of Morgan Stanley Asia from 1991 to 2001, Jack built its business to 2000 people, 11 offices, and joint ventures in China and India. He has since developed a venture capital business in China and the US.
