

**Matthew Nimetz '60.** Matt Nimetz was a Rhodes Scholar at Oxford and is a graduate of Harvard Law School. After clerking for Justice John Harlan, he worked in the Johnson White House before practicing law in New York. He was Counselor to the Department of State and later Undersecretary for Security Assistance, Science and Technology during the Carter Administration. He was a partner at Paul, Weiss, Rifkind, Wharton and Garrison from 1981 to 2000, when he joined General Atlantic, a global private equity firm where he is Managing Director and COO. Matt's many diplomatic assignments for the U.S. and UN have included mediating disputes in Macedonia and Cyprus. He is a trustee emeritus of Williams and serves on several other boards.
